PLUTA restructuring expert Dr Thiemann finds investor for WPM

Dr Stephan Thiemann from PLUTA Rechtsanwalts GmbH has succeeded in finding an investor for WPM Werkstoffprüfsysteme Leipzig GmbH, a producer of testing machines. The restructuring expert sold the company to Kögel Werkstoff- und Materialprüfsysteme GmbH, which has taken over the business operations with effect from 1 December 2019.

PLUTA restructuring expert Dr Thiemann expressed his satisfaction with the sale, saying "We have kept the business going and have been able to find a strategic investor for this long-established company within four months. All twelve employees will be kept on." This means that the business of the company, which arose from a craft business founded in 1881, will be preserved. The corresponding purchase agreement has already been signed by the persons responsible, who have agreed to maintain confidentiality about the purchase price.

Alongside Dr Thiemann, the PLUTA team also included Mr Gerd Kämpfe.
