the company has managed to generate annual revenues of around 1.6 million euros. The reason for filing for insolvency is liquidity problems, which resulted from promised orders not being awarded or being postponed.

The attorney Mr Stefan Meyer will arrange for the prefinancing of the insolvency substitute benefits as soon as possible, which will ensure that employee wages and salaries are guaranteed for a period of three months. The Spenge-based company has a workforce of 30 employees. On 30 January 2018, a staff meeting took place in which the employees were informed of the situation.
